2014-2015 Tuition and Fees

International Student Fees (F-1 Visa)

<i>New Hope Academy School Fees</i>	
Application Fee	\$100 USD
International Student I-20 Processing Fee/Tuition Deposit - This fee/deposit must be paid after the student is accepted into our program and before the I-20 is issued. This fee will be considered a deposit towards the student's tuition and fees for the school year. An additional fee will need to be paid to Sevis to process the F-1 visa application.	\$500 USD
<i>If the student's visa is denied, we will refund \$250 of this fee. If the visa is approved but the student decides not to attend New Hope Academy for some other reason, or if the student does not complete the visa application process, no portion of the fee will be refunded. This fee is payable for each year a student plans to attend our school.</i>	
Tuition and Academic Fees for ESL Transition Program (all new students and returning students based on testing at end of previous academic year)	\$18,000 USD
<i>Payment Plan: Pay \$9,000 by August 10, 2014 and \$8,500 (after applying \$500 deposit) by January 10, 2015. If new student tests into English Proficient Program, difference in tuition will be credited to second semester payment. If a student transitions to the English Proficient Program by the end of the first semester, second semester payment will be reduced accordingly.</i>	
Tuition and Academic Fees for English Proficient Program (approved returning students and new students placed into this program after testing at school)	\$13,500 USD
<i>Payment Plan: Pay \$6,500 by August 10, 2014 and \$6,500 (after applying \$500 deposit) by January 10, 2015.</i>	

Special Fees:

Food Tech Fee - for students enrolled in Food Tech high school class	\$150 USD
Graduation Fee - covers costs of cap & gown rental, commemorative tassel, display-quality diploma, invitations, cake and decorations for graduation ceremony for family and friends	\$60 USD
<i>In order to receive a High School diploma from New Hope Academy, a student must be enrolled in our school as a full-time student for at least one full academic year and must complete all graduation requirements.</i>	

<i>Other Financial Requirements</i>	
Housing through Host Family (if arranged through New Hope Academy). This amount will be paid directly to the Host Family divided over 3 payments. These payments cover food and housing costs for 42 weeks@ \$200/week .	\$8,400 USD
School Supplies and Miscellaneous Needs - Student should have these funds available to cover personal expenses. (Suggested minimum amount.)	\$500 USD
